## **POMEGRANATE JELLY**

## **Ingredients:**

- 3-3/4 cup pomegranate juice
- 1 package of pectin
- 5 cups of sugar

## **Directions:**

**Prepare juice:** When using fresh squeezed

juice be sure to run it through a strainer lined with cheesecloth to separate any remaining bits.

**Prepare canning jars:** Place clean canning jars and lids top side down in a 13×9 cake pan placed on the stove. Add water and heat until boiling. Heated jars will not crack when adding the hot jelly to them.

Bring pomegranate juice and pectin to a rolling boil: Add pomegranate juice and pectin to a 6-quart pan. Stir and turn heat on high. Bring to a boil, stirring constantly to prevent scorching.

Add sugar: When your juice has come to a rolling boil add the sugar and stir well. Return to a boil and boil hard for exactly 2 minutes, continuing to stir]. Remove from heat. Tip: A tiny pat of butter on swirled on top of the jelly will help to remove the foam. Let the jelly sit for a minute and skim off remaining foam.

5 Fill jars: Fill jars to 1/2" of the top. Wipe rims clean. Screw on 2-piece lids.

If you plan on storing your jelly in the pantry place in a water bath for 5 minutes. Otherwise store in your refrigerator.

**Options:** add 2-3 Tbsp of lemon juice for a nice zing, or dice and seed up to 8 jalapeño peppers and add to the juice at the beginning of the recipe. There's something delicious about a hint of heat in a sweet treat! Enjoy!
