60 Minute Parmesan Breadsticks

Ingredients

- 1 Tbsp yeast
- 1 1/2 C warm water
- 2 Tbsp granulated sugar
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 3 C all-purpose flour
- 1/2 C butter
- Parmesan cheese
- garlic powder
- salt



Instructions

- 1. Preheat the oven to 375 degree F.
- 2. Place the butter in a jelly roll pan and place in the oven while preheating
- 3. In the bowl of your Bosch mixer dissolve yeast in the warm water and sugar, let sit for 5 mins (the yeast will start to grow and poof).
- 4. Add the salt and 1 1/2-2 C flour and mix with a dough hook until dough is smooth and elastic.
- 5. Add remaining flour, 1/4-1/2 C at a time, mixing well, the dough will still be sticky.
- 6. Mix (kneed) 3 min more.
- 7. Roll dough into a ball and turn over once in a greased bowl, cover with a damp towel.
- 8. Let rise in a warm place, free from drafts for 10 min
- 9. Place the dough onto a floured counter and roll out into a rectangle 10x9 inches, about 1/2 inch thick.
- 10. Cut dough into 5 in x 1 inch strips (18).
- 11. Roll the breadstick in the butter, and spread out on the jelly roll pan
- 12. Cover and Let rise 10 min more.
- 13. Sprinkle with parmesan cheese, salt and garlic powder, as much or as little as you want
- 14. Bake at 375 for 18-20 min, until they are slightly golden.
