Apple Mug Pies

Ingredients:

3 large gala or fuji apples, peeled, cored and cut into 1/2-inch pieces

1/4 cup packed brown sugar

1/4 cup granulated sugar

3 tablespoons all-purpose flour

2 tablespoons freshly squeezed lemon juice

1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1/2 teaspoon cornstarch

1/2 teaspoon kosher salt

1/4 teaspoon nutmeg

2 tablespoons unsalted butter

1/2 cup all-purpose flour

1/4 cup old-fashioned rolled oats

1/4 cup packed brown sugar

1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1/2 teaspoon kosher salt

4 ounces (1 stick) unsalted butter, cold, cut into small pieces nonstick cooking spray, for the mugs



Directions:

For the filling: Preheat the oven to 375 degrees F.

Combine the apples, sugars, flour, lemon juice, cinnamon, cornstarch, salt and nutmeg in a medium bowl and stir to combine. Melt the butter in a 12-inch skillet over medium heat. Add the apple mixture and cook, stirring frequently, until the apples start to soften, 5 to 8 minutes. Turn off the heat and set aside.

For the streusel topping: Add the flour, oats, brown sugar, cinnamon, salt and butter to the Bosch food processor attachment and pulse a couple of times until it resembles coarse, wet sand. (Do not overmix.) Set aside. Coat the insides of 4 oven-safe coffee mugs with cooking spray, then place them in a 9-inch square baking pan. Fill the mugs about three-quarters of the way with the apple mixture, then top each with 1/4 cup streusel topping. Bake until the top is golden brown, 25 to 30 minutes. Cool until warm to the touch, about 20 minutes.
