Banana Cupcakes with Peanut Butter Icing

CUPCAKES:

¾ cup sugar (I use less)½ cup quinoa flour1/3 cup plus 2 T grape seed oil½ cup plus 2 T ground hard white wheat¾ cup mashed bananas (about 1 ½ medium)flour1 egg2 T ultra gel1/3 cup plus 2 T buttermilk¾ tsp baking soda¾ tsp vanilla½ tsp salt½ cup chocolate chips

Preheat oven to 350 F. Line a 12 cup muffin tin with liners or spray with Vegelene. In Bosch Mixer Bowl, with the batter/cookie whisks attached, whisk together the sugar and oil. Whisk in the banana, egg, buttermilk and vanilla. In a separate bowl, sift together the flours, ultra gel, baking soda, and salt.

Add the flour mixture and the chocolate chips into the banana mixture in the Bosch bowl. Use the 'momentary' switch to just combine the wet and dry ingredients. Fill muffin cups ³/₄ full.

Bake 20 minutes. Let cool then frost.

PEANUT BUTTER ICING

6 T soft butter 1/8 cup brown sugar 1 T dark brown sugar ¼ tsp salt 1 cup creamy peanut butter 1 cup sifted icing sugar ¹/₄ cup cream 1 tsp vanilla

Add all ingredients to Bosch Bowl with French (regular) whisks attached. Cream well, scraping sides of bowl occasionally. Ensure ingredients are creamed well to avoid crunchy bits.
