## Bob's Soft Sugar Cookies

- $11 / 2$ cups Sugar
- 1/2 cup Light corn syrup (Karo)
- 1 cup Shortening
- $1 / 2$ cup Margarine
- 2 Eggs
- 1 tsp Vanilla
- 1 cup Milk
- 1 tsp Salt

- 8 tsp Baking powder
- 1 tsp Baking soda
- $61 / 2$ cups All-purpose flour


## Recipe Instructions

In Bosch mixing bowl using cookie paddles, cream sugar, corn syrup, butter, shortening, eggs, and vanilla. Add milk and mix slowly. Add dry ingredients. Dough will be a little sticky. Refrigerate covered for 1 hour. Roll out on floured surface $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ thick. Cut out with cookie cutter. Place on ungreased cookie sheet. Bake 10-12 minutes at $375^{\circ}$.

## Optional Raisin Filling:

2 cups raisins cooked in 3 cups water. Add $3 / 4$ cup sugar, $1 / 2$ tsp vanilla, and thicken with cornstarch (about 3 Tbsp). Put 1 big Tbsp filling between 2 dough circles. Press edges well. Bake as directed above.
