## CHOCOLATE CHIP SOUR CREAM COFFE E CAKE BY ASHLEE MARIE

This chocolate chip sour cream coffee cake recipe is easy to make, soft, moist and always a huge hit. The mini chocolate chips go beautifully with the cinnamon swirl but they can of course be left out for a classic coffee cake recipe.

# **Ingredients**

#### Cake

- 1/2 C butter softened
- 1 C sugar 1 Tbsp for high altitude
- 1/4 C light brown sugar packed
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 2 Irg eggs
- 2 1/2 C flour + 2 1/2 Tbsp for high altitude
- 1 tsp baking soda 1/8 tsp for high altitude
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1/2 C sour cream
- 1 C milk + 2 tsp for high altitude
- ½ C mini chocolate chips

#### **Brown Sugar Filling**

- 1 C light brown sugar packed
- 1 1/2 Tbsp cinnamon
- 1/4 tsp nutmeg
- 3 tsp cocoa powder
- 1/4 tsp salt

#### **Cinnamon Streusel Topping**

- 1/3 C sugar
- 1/2 C all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 4 Tbsp butter cold, in cubes

## **Instructions**

## **Cake Batter**

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees (375 for high altitude)
- 2. Beat together the butter and sugars until light and fluffy, then beat in the vanilla.
- 3. Add the eggs, one at a time, beating for 1 minute after adding each one. Scrape the sides of the bowl as needed.
- 4. In a small bowl, whisk together the flour, baking soda, and salt.
- 5. In another small bowl, whisk together the milk and sour cream until well combined.
- 6. With the mixer on low speed, add 1/3 flour, 1/2 milk, 1/3 flour, 1/2 milk and finally the last of the flour
- 7. add the mini chocolate chips and do a final stir to incorporate evenly

#### Brown sugar filling

1. In a small bowl, whisk together the brown sugar, cinnamon, nutmeg, cocoa powder and salt.

#### **Cinnamon Streusel Topping**

- 1. Add the sugar, flour and cinnamon to a food processor pulse (or whisk in a bowl)
- 2. Add butter pulse until crumbly (you could also add melted butter to a bowl and just stir until crumbly)

## Assembly and baking

- 1. prepare a 9x13 pan with a non stick spray I prefer Bakers Joy
- 2. Spread half of your batter in the bottom of your prepared pan
- 3. sprinkle your brown sugar filling on top of the batter.
- 4. Dollop the rest of your cake batter on top of your filling, using a spatula to carefully spread the batter across the pan.
- 5. Use a butter knife, gently swirl the filling into the batter.
- 6. Sprinkle all of the streusel on your cake.
