CRUNCHIE CHOCOATE BARK

- •40 soda crackers
- •1 cup butter
- •1 1/8 cups light brown sugar (firmly packed)
- •2 cups semi-sweet chocolate chips
- •½ cup pecans (toasted & chopped).

Instructions:

- 1. Preheat oven to $350^{\circ}F$ ($175^{\circ}C$).
- 2. Place crackers on a greased, parchment paper-lined baking sheet so that the entire surface is covered.
- 3. In a saucepan, melt butter on low heat. Once melted, add brown sugar and turn heat to medium. Continue stirring until boiling, then boil for 3 minutes.
- 4. Pour the caramel over the crackers, spreading evenly with a spatula. Bake for 5 minutes. Pour the chocolate chips over the crackers and cover with tin foil for 3 minutes.
- 5. Remove the foil and spread the softened chocolate over the top evenly. Sprinkle with pecans, cover with foil, and freeze for 1 hour.
- 6. Break the bark up into pieces. Enjoy \$\frac{1}{2}\$
