MONSTER DOUGH STARTER

2 c warm water Mix all the ingredients together until smooth. Cover with a

2 c fresh ground wheat flour cloth and set in a warm place for 5 days. Refrigerate.

Pour off as required for your recipe. Replenish with 2 c flour, 2 c warm water and 1/4 c sugar. Store in refrigerator.

CINNAMON BUNS DOUGH

1/3 c oil
In Bosch mixer bowl with dough hook attached, add monster
dough starter, oil and egg. Beat well on speed 1. Add remaining
ingredients and mix well. If dough is sticky, add more flour.

2 c wheat flour
Knead on speed 2 for 2 minutes. Remove dough and roll out on
well floured surface. Spread with butter, cinnamon, sugar or your
favourite cinnamon roll filling. Roll up and cut into 3/4" slices.

1 t baking soda Place in baking tray and bake in 400 deg oven for 15 – 20 mins

MONSTER MUFFINS

Dry Ingredients: Wet Ingredients:

 $1^{1/2}$ c wheat flour 1 egg, lightly beaten

1/2 c brown sugar 1/2 c buttermilk

1/2 c rye flour (or rolled oats) 1/2 c oil

Add dry ingredients to Bosch mixer bowl with cookie whisks attached. Beat on speed 1 until ingredients are well mixed. In a separate bowl mix the wet ingredients together. Add wet ingredients to Bosch bowl and beat on speed one until just mixed. Fill greased muffin tins 3/4 full. Bake at $375 \deg$ for 20-25 mins.

MONSTER BISCUITS

2 c wheat flour 1/2 c shortening

1/2 t baking soda 1 c Monster Dough Starter

2 t baking powder 2 t honey

In Bosch mixer bowl with cookie whisks attached, combine flour, soda, baking powder, salt and shortening. Mix on speed one until blended. Add monster dough starter, milk and honey. Mix on speed one for one minute. Remove dough from bowl and pat into rectangle 1/2" thick. Cut biscuit shapes and bake on greased baking sheet at 400 deg for 20 mins.
