Stuffed Hot Chocolate Monkey Bread From Ashlee Marie

Ingredients

Dough

- 3/4 C warm water around 112 degrees
- 1 Tbsp reg. yeast
- 1 tsp sugar
- 1 C evaporated milk
- 1/2 C melted butter
- 1/2 C sugar
- 5+ C white read flour
- 1 Tbsp oil

Stuffing

- 1 1/2 C mini chocolate chips
- 1 1/2 C mini marshmallows

Topping

- 1/2 C butter melted
- 1/2 C packed light brown sugar
- 1/2 C hot chocolate mix

Hot Chocolate caramel sauce

- 1/2 C butter
- 1/2 C brown sugar
- 1/3 C hot chocolate mix
- 1/3 C whipping cream

Instructions

Dough

- 1. In your mixer with the dough hook, add the yeast, 1 tsp sugar and the warm water let it sit for 10 mins to proof
- 2. add the melted butter, the rest of the sugar and evaporated milk and stir until all incorporated.
- 3. add 2 C of the bread flour and mix until smooth
- 4. while mixing add 1/2 C of the flour at a time, letting the flour mix in completely each time. Beat until the mixture starts to clean the bowl
- 5. keep beating until the dough can be pulled and stretched without being sticky and without ripping.
- 6. place the dough in an oiled bowl, and make sure the dough is totally covered in oil. Cover the dough and let rise until doubled in size.
- 7. while the dough is rising prepare the other ingredients

Popping

1. mix the hot chocolate mixture and sugar and set aside

Hot Chocolate Caramel Sauce

- 1. in a small saucepan melt the butter and brown sugar together and bring to a boil
- 2. add the hot chocolate mix and stir until smooth
- 3. add the heavy whipping cream and stir until smooth

Assembly

- 1. Preheat the oven to 350
- 2. spray your bundt pan with non stick baking spray
- 3. knock down the dough and divide into 1 inch balls
- 4. flatten each ball, add a few marshmallows and chocolate chips and pinch closed sealing the balls
- 5. roll the balls in the melted butter and then in the cocoa/sugar mixture
- 6. place half the balls into your bundt pan, sprinkle extra chocolate chips and marshmallows in the pan, along with 1/3 of the caramel sauce

- add the rest of the balls and the rest of the caramel sauce
 Bake for 40-50 mins cover the monkey bread with foil after 30 mins to keep it from getting to browned
 9. invert the budnt pan onto a large plate, unmold, serve and enjoy!
