## Sweet Pickle Relish

## **Ingredients**

- 4 cups cucumbers, deseeded and chopped
- 2 cups onions, chopped
- 1 cup green bell pepper, chopped
- 1 cup red bell pepper, chopped
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup kosher salt
- 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cups sugar
- 2 cups cider vinegar
- 1 tablespoon celery seed
- 1 tablespoon mustard seeds



## **DIRECTIONS**

- 1. To deseed cucumbers, I cut them in half lengthwise and scoop out the seeds with my finger.
- 2. Put all the vegetables through the Bosch meat grinder with the regular disc that comes with it ( 4.5 mm.)
- 3. Put all the vegetables in a large bowl.
- 4. Sprinkle the salt over the ground vegetables.
- 5. Cover with cold water and let stand for 2 hours.
- 6. Drain vegetables well, then press out as much liquid as possible.
- 7. In a large pot, combine sugar, vinegar and seeds.
- 8. Bring to a boil.
- 9. Add vegetables.
- 10. Bring back to a boil and simmer for 10 minutes.
- 11. Using a slotted spoon, put into pint jars according to standard canning procedures.
- 12. (Note: Although some of the brine needs to go in the jars, I use a slotted spoon to keep it from being too soupy.).
