White Chocolate Pumpkin Snickerdoodles

½ cup unsalted butter, melted

1/2 cup white sugar

6 Tbsp. brown sugar

1 egg

6 Tbsp. Pumpkin puree

¾ tsp. vanilla

1½ cup flour

½ tsp. baking powder

1 ½ tsp. cornstarch

¼ tsp. salt

¾ tsp. cinnamon

¼ tsp. nutmeg

¼ tsp. cloves

¼ tsp. ginger

½ cup white chocolate chips

½ cup sugar mixed with 1 tsp. cinnamon



Directions

- 1. Cream together the butter and sugars using the Bosch mixer and the whips.
- 2. Add in the eggs and mix another 30 sec.
- 3. Add the pumpkin and vanilla and mix another 30 sec.
- 4. Change the whips out for the cookie paddles and add all the dry ingredients and spices and mix until all in incorporated.
- 5. Add the white Chocolate chips and jog the mixer until mixed in.
- 6. In a separate bowl have the extra white sugar in cinnamon mixed and shape balls of dough and drop them into the sugar mixture to coat.
- 7. Place cookies on greased baking sheet and if you wish press down with something flat (I like to use the bottom of a glass)
- 8. Bake at 350 F. degrees for 10 to 15 min.
- 9. Let cool before removing from pan.
