## Salmon Pot Pie

## Ingredients:

2 to 3 tablespoons chopped onions

4 tablespoons cooking fat

4 tablespoons flour

2 cups milk

1/2 cup grated cheese

1 (14 3/4-ounce) can salmon drained, flaked,

bones removed

1 (15-ounce) can peas drained; (or substitute

frozen, thawed and drained)

salt to taste

pepper to taste

baking powder biscuits, unbaked

**BAKING POWDER BISCUITS** 

2 cups flour

1 tablespoon sugar optional

1 teaspoon salt

4 teaspoons baking powder

4 tablespoons shortening softened (or butter or coconut oil)

1 cup milk

## Directions:

Cook onion in fat; stir in flour. Add milk slowly, stirring constantly. Cook until thickened; add cheese, salmon and seasoning. Heat mixture through, stirring occasionally. Place in greased 2-quart baking dish; top with unbaked biscuits. Bake at 350° F for 30 minutes. (Mrs. J. C. Fox, Pleasant Grange No. 1615, Lancaster, OH)

NOTES: For the cream sauce you can substitute Cream of Mushroom soup, with only a half can or so of water, and then add less salt. You can also substitute French's Fried Onions crumbled; stir well into casserole ingredients.

## **BISCUIT DIRECTIONS**

Sift flour, sugar, salt and baking powder into a bowl; cut in shortening with the batter whisks for the Bosch or by hand with a pastry cutter. Add 1 cup milk or enough to make dough easily handled and jog the machine to mix lightly. Roll 1/2 to 3/4-inch thick; place on baking sheet. Bake at 425° F for 15 minutes or till nicely browned: Brushing the tops with Eggbeaters adds an appetizing gloss to the baked biscuits, or sprinkle biscuits with grated Parmesan cheese for added flavor.
