Pink Easter Dinner Rolls

Ingredients

Rolls

- 1 package or 1 TBSP dry yeast
- 1/4 cup warm water
- 1/4 sugar
- 1/4 cup oil
- 1 tsp salt
- 3 cups flour
- 1 cup scalded milk
- 1 egg

Recipe Instructions

- 1. Dissolve yeast in warm water, let sit for -10 minutes until frothy.
- 2. In mixer bowl add yeast, sugar, oil, salt and egg. With whisks on turn mixer to speed 1 and mix briefly. (add 3-4 drops of food coloring if you want tinted rolls)
- 3. Put dough hook in mixer and slowly add 2 cups of flour while mixer is running.
- 4. Slowly drizzle scalded milk into running mixer. You must add it slowly so the hot milk won't kill the yeast.
- 5. Add last cup of flour until dough forms a ball and cleans the bowl of the mixer. You may need a little more flour.
- 6. This is a soft dough so it doesn't need to knead for long, just a couple of minutes.
- 7. Raise for 1-1/2-2 hours (minimum of 1 hour)
- 8. Punch down and shape into knots, with ends tucked under (use about an 8 inch rope of dough to tie knots)
- 9. Raise again 1-1/2-2 hrs
- 10. Bake at 400° for 10-12 minutes.
